

EGF150 Clear Emergency Glazing Film

EGF150 is a self wound, low density polyethylene film with a pressure sensitive adhesive and has been designed to be applied to broken glass prior to replacement. Its application is intended to provide a safety barrier and to help prevent broken glass falling out as well as providing a degree of waterproofing prior to replacement.

SPECIFICATION:

Construction: Consists of a low density polyethylene film with a rubber

based pressure sensitive adhesive on one side.

Colour: Natural Polyethylene

Film thickness: 0.125 mm + /- 0.02 mm

Roll size: 1000mm x 20m

Guideline application instructions for EGF150

- 1. Frame should be clean
- 2. For small panes, film can be pulled off the roll, cut to size and stuck directly over breakage.
- 3. For larger panes, peel a few centimetres off the roll and stick to top of frame and simply pull down over the breakage and trim off to desired length.
- 4. When overlapping on very large panes overlap at least 150mm.
- 5. Film should be smoothed onto glass so that it is stuck; but not too much pressure should be applied especially where break is jagged.
