We stock the 175-micron film which comes on a paper liner which means you are able to cut the film to the correct size before installing it to the glass to create a neater appearance.

It is excellent to use in public places such as schools, hospitals, offices and shops. It is a very strong, durable film which is designed to keep your staff and customers around the glass safe from any further splintering of glass and breakage until the window is replaced. Also it provides a certain amount of waterproofing while waiting for the replacement to be fitted.
